



What is Discord?

Discord is a chat application in which we have set up a community of Matched Bettors, it's much more fluid than an on-site forum and allows you to hide your identity easier than Facebook. You can use it on your desktop browser, or via apps for your phone or desktop.

I'm in. Now what?

Take a look through the channels on the left of your screen and jump right in! You will find various categories for discussing Sports, Casino and Acca offers, as well as our Dutching strategy.

Notifications? How do I get them?

One of the most useful features of Discord is the ability to receive notifications from the channels you want. To set these up, you want to click on the 'v' symbol in the top left of the app (next to the server name), and click on 'notification settings'. In 'server notification settings' you're probably going to want to tick 'Only @mentions' which will mean you will get notifications if anyone tags your username in a message.

After that, scroll down to the 'notification overrides' sections. In here you can pick any channels which you'd like to receive ALL notifications for by adding a tick to 'all' next to each chosen channel.

Any rules?

Unfortunately, yes. In order to make the chatroom a welcome, friendly and useful place for all, please read and adhere to the following rules:

NO ABUSIVE MESSAGES OR BEHAVIOUR TOWARDS STAFF OR OTHER MEMBERS

While we all have bad days and don't mind a grumble now and again – long-term persistent negativity is not wanted by anyone.

DO NOT DISCUSS OTHER PAID-FOR BETTING PRODUCTS OR SERVICES NOT ASSOCIATED WITH PROFIT SQUAD OR MATCHED BETS

We do not tolerate spam and any post related to 3rd party products and services will be edited or removed

BE RESPECTFUL TO EACH OTHER

Positivity breeds positivity, so let's be friends! You never know who might discover the next loophole or profitable strategy, so if you want them to share it with you, try to avoid arguments and remember we're all here for the same reasons.

TRY AND POST IN RELEVANT THREADS

This is to make it easier for others to find what they want to read and contribute to. Continually chatting in no chat threads may result in your posts being removed

MULTI-ACCOUNTING

We do not condone or encourage multiple account abuse as it is against bookmaker's terms & conditions. However, we encourage freedom of speech so long as it is clean and useful and as such, we won't be forcing people to stop talking about that kind of thing but we won't be answering questions about it.

Access to the Discord group is a privilege which can be revoked if these rules are repeatedly broken

How do I get involved?

No Chat?!

Each category has it's own 'no chat' channel. The purpose of these is to post any new offers you find or good matches for current offers. The reason we don't want any chat in these channels is to allow members to enable notifications on them so they can see anything important and don't get a notification every 10 seconds from people chatting.

Each category also has it's own chat channel, so chat as much as you want there!

Nobody is answering my questions!

Although we endeavour to answer any questions requiring our attention in the chats, on busy days there is always the chance that your question can get buried in amongst the rest of the chat.

To get our attention (and anyone else's for that matter!) you can simply type @ and select our username from the list that pops up. If you are not sure which mods are 'on-shift' at any time, just look at the top of the members list on the right and any mods with a green circle next to their name should get back to you as soon as they can. If it's out of hours or it's not clear who is working, you can simply add @mod to the start of your message and one of us will pick it up when we are back online.
